*Overnight and Undernight Specials

Each session lasts four days from Monday through Thursday. Campers can attend mornings, afternoons, or full day.

Full Day: 8am-5pm; ½ Day Morning: 8am-12:30pm; ½ Day Afternoon: 11:30am-5pm.

Campers may register for as many sessions as they want as long as there are slots available.

Campers: Age range from 6 and up (not all 6 year olds are ready for chess). Our camp caters to all levels of chess players.

Director: Lorene Lampert, Chief Operating Officer of the School Chess Association, has many years experience in coaching chess and working with children of all ages.

School Chess Association Summer camp offers:

- Professional (Licensed) teachers who know children and how to teach them.
- Chess instruction tailored to the students' individual needs.
- Five levels of instruction (beginning, advanced beginners, intermediate, advanced, and super advanced) each under the direction of a separate teacher.
- A wide variety of optional activities in addition to chess instruction and merit point tournament, including swimming, water slides, field ball, Magic the Gathering, soccer, tennis, roller skating, bowling, sign language, bus ride to activities, and role playing games. No extra charge for activities. Campers are always under supervision.
- SCA Camp shirts for \$16.00 (Checks payable to School Chess Association). **Chess sets** available for \$19.00.
- Lunch will be provided and catered each day.
- ***Overnight/Undernight Specials** are open to any camper registered in any week summer of 2010. Those staying all night will have breakfast in the morning. Activities will be swimming, movie and popcorn, swimming, tennis, volleyball, D&D, and Magic the Gathering, as well as many other activities. The overnight will be through Thursday with pick up on Thursday afternoon.

Undernight is for younger campers who are not yet ready for an overnight, or 1st grade and younger. Undernight pick up is at 8:00 p.m. Wednesday evening. Both programs will include dinner, swimming and evening program.

Fee: Overnight \$70.00 - Undernight \$35.00

Written confirmation, carpooling lists, and tax forms are mailed approximately **two weeks** before the start of your camper's 1st session. **Please keep your tax forms.**

What to bring to camp:

CHESS SET and PENCIL each day (Only grades K-2 in the Beginner or the Advanced Beginner group need not bring a chess set, one will be provided).

SWIMMING SUIT and TOWEL if you wish to swim.

OVERNIGHT: Sleeping bag, Pillow, PJ's, Toiletry Bag.

Please label EVERYTHING you bring to camp - your child's name and phone number should be on all items of clothing.

Cost:

Full Day: 8:00-5:00 \$230.00/week - \$250.00 at door (at door registration not always available) **or postmarked less than two weeks prior to session**, includes all activities and two chess instructional periods daily, awards ceremony and auction on the last day of camp in the afternoon. Parents are welcome to attend the awards ceremony starting about 4:15 pm on Thursdays.

Morning Only and Afternoon Only have limited enrollment – full time registrations are given priority.

½ Day Morning: \$225.00/week - \$245.00 at door or postmarked less than two weeks prior to session.

A.M. only: 8:00am-12:30pm, includes snack, lunch, outdoor activities and one chess instruction.

½ Day Afternoon: \$225.00/week - \$245.00 at door or postmarked less than two weeks prior to session.

P.M. only: 11:30am-5:00pm, includes snack, lunch, outdoor activities, swim, field trips, and one chess instruction.

Specials: Overnight - \$70.00; Undernight - \$35.00.

Other Charges: Change in Registration - \$15.00; Cancellation - \$50.00
