Bring a chess set, pencil, notation paper, and a chess clock (if available) to all tournaments. Chess set loaners are no longer available for use during rounds; chess sets may be purchased at the concession area when available.

At-door registration is from 7:30 - 8:30 a.m. Players who arrive after 8:30 a.m. may not be paired in the 1st round (unless pre-registered and pre-paid). If pre-registered and pre-paid, players must arrive by 8:30 a.m.

<u>AWARDS</u> - SCA awards trophy prizes to the top three players in each section (K-2, 3-5, 6-8, 9-12) and a superior performance trophy to 4th and 5th place in our standard tournaments. Rated section trophies depend on the number of players in that section. Tie breakers are used in all sections when appropriate.

Concessions will be available at all tournaments.

Entry fees are \$24.00 per player with a \$1.00 discount for each sibling. On-site registration will be \$29.00 per player (and \$28.00 per additional sibling). ID cards are still \$2.00.

Unless pre-registered, a School Chess Association ID card must be brought to all tournaments, including rated chess. The SCA encourages all players to pre-register as this allows for timely starting times.

The statewide championship will have different times and entry fees.

At this time the SCA will still require masks to be worn at all times at our tournaments. This policy will be reviewed throughout the academic year.
