Location: Breck School, Golden Valley, 123 Ottawa Avenue North – From North take highway 100S from South take highway 100N to the Glenwood Avenue exit go east on Glenwood and turn left on Ottawa avenue, School at end of road.

Pre-registrations on reverse side of flier.

- Individual players compete for the titles of Open Primary Champion and Open Elementary Champion with the top 16 in each tournament qualifying for free entry to the Tournament of Champions on May 1st at Metcalf Jr. High to determine the title of School Chess Association Statewide Primary Champion and School Chess Association Statewide Elementary Champion.
- Schools compete for Team Awards in primary and elementary divisions.
- Over \$2,000 dollars of individual and team trophies and medals will be awarded.
- Tournament lasts two days. Seven round Swiss-style pairing (no elimination).

Team Details

- Team trophies in both elementary (4-6) and primary (Kdg-3) will be awarded.
- No limit to the number of players from any school.
- All team members must be from the same school. Home-schooled players may represent the school that is in their attendance area.
- Team scores based on top four players from each school.
- Players do not need to be a member of a team to participate for individual trophies.

Notes

- Parents are welcome to stay or leave. Hot food and concessions are available.
- Players are responsible for bringing their own chess sets. Bring chess clock if available.
- Gym will be available on both days.
- Up to two $\frac{1}{2}$ point byes can be requested before 1st round. No $\frac{1}{2}$ point bye will be given for round 7. 0 point byes can be requested for any round with advance notification.

Registration

- Advance registration (both tournaments) is \$29.00 per player (\$28.00 per additional player if two or more siblings register at the same time.)
- Those pre-registered can check on-line for accuracy of registration.
- Advance registration must be postmarked no later than April 10th.
- Advance registration players should arrive by 8:45 a.m. Saturday.
- Late registration (after April 10th or at the door) is \$39.00 per player.
- At door registration is from 7:45 to 8:15 a.m. Saturday.
- Bring bar code card for at door registration (\$2.00 charge if forgotten).
- Registration will be confirmed on the website

Sunday: Primary play will be done by about 2:30 p.m. Elementary play done by about 2:30 p.m.

Award ceremony will start about 30 minutes after the conclusion of the tournament.
