**Location:** Camp is held this year at the Minnesota JCC location 4330 South Cedar Lake Road, 55416 in St Louis Park. **Sessions:** Dates can be found on the registration form. Each session lasts four days, Monday through Thursday, Campers can attend morning, afternoons, or full day.

**Full Day:** 8am-5pm, **½ Day Morning:** 8am-12:30pm or **½ Day Afternoon:** 11:30pm-5pm.

Campers may register for as many sessions as they want as long as there is space available.

### **Campers:**

Age ranges from 6 and up (not all 6-year old's are ready for chess). We cater to chess players of all levels.

### **School Chess Association Summer camp offers:**

- Professional (Licensed) teachers who know children and how to teach them.
- Chess instruction tailored to the students' individual needs.
- Five levels of instruction (beginning, advanced beginners, intermediate, advanced, and super advanced) each under the direction of a separate teacher or chess master.
- A wide variety of optional activities in addition to chess instruction and merit-point tournaments, including swimming, Magic the Gathering, soccer, Pickleball, roller skating, bowling, fishing, sign language, bus ride to activities, and role playing games. **No extra charge for activities.** Campers are always under supervision.
- Lunch is provided and catered each day. **PLEASE SEND A BEVERAGE WITH YOUR CHILD EACH DAY.**

Written confirmation, carpooling lists, and TAX FORMS ARE E-MAILED approximately two weeks before the start of your camper's 1<sup>st</sup> session. **Please keep your tax forms, they will be the only one you receive.**

### **What to bring to camp:**

**PENCIL** each day

**SWIMMING SUIT** and **TOWEL** if your child plans to swim.

**LABELS** on all clothes you bring to camp – (child's name and phone number)

### **Options:**

**Full Day: 8:00-5:00 \$430.00/week** (at door registration or postmarked less than two weeks prior to session not always available.) Includes all activities and two chess instructional periods daily; awards ceremony last day of camp in the afternoon.

**Morning Only and Afternoon Only** have limited enrollment – full time registrations are given priority.

**½ Day Morning: \$425.00/week 8:00am-12:30pm, includes snack, lunch, outdoor activities and one chess instruction.**

**½ Day Afternoon: \$425.00/week 11:30am-5:00pm, includes snack, lunch, swim/field trips and one chess instruction.**

*Parents are welcome to attend the awards ceremony starting about 4:15 pm on Thursdays.*

**BALANCE OF ALL CAMP FEES ARE DUE 14 DAYS PRIOR TO CAMP.**

### **Fees:**

\$430.00 Full day

\$425.00 Half day

\$20.00 SCA Camp shirt

### **Late Registration:**

\$20.00 late fee when registering less than 14 days before session

### **Change in Registration:**

\$20.00 transfer week fee (must be requested in advance in writing). We can only honor this if we have space.

### **Cancellation fee schedule:**

\$50.00 is not refundable up until 14 days prior to camp week.

**Half** of the total fee is refundable if notified by Thursday at 8 am prior to the week of camp.

**No refund** is available after Thursday at 8 am prior to the week of camp.
